Welcome to our Fall 2008 Charity Ball. This is our main fundraiser for the year and we are pleased that you have joined us for this fine affair. Many thanks to the Lions who worked to make this year's Ball possible. And many thanks to our Supporters who have purchased Stars, Advertisements, Patronage and provided donations in goods.

The District 16-B Charitable Foundation allows the Lions Clubs of our district to "Do together what we as individuals can not do alone." Our Past District Governor, Dr. Stanton Deitch, had the foresight in 1968 to spearhead the creation of this Foundation. PDG Deitch created the solution for these clubs – The District 16B Charitable Foundation. Through this Foundation, District Lions Clubs are able to contract with the Foundation for a loan to obtain the needed amount of money to fund a project now while giving the club three years to operate fundraisers or events to generate the money to repay the loan over the next three years. This is the basic service of the Foundation. Some Lion sponsored projects are also eligible for grants that do not require repayment. Grants deplete the Foundation's assets and are limited in amount to help preserve the Foundation's ability to survive as a resource for the Clubs of our District. Grants, like the loans, are requested on applications and reviewed by the Trustees who represent the Lions of District 16B.

The Foundation is here to assist Lions to accomplish their projects in the near term and is truly Lions helping Lions to help our communities and mankind.

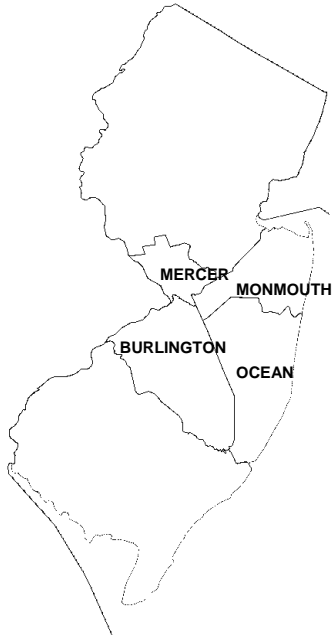
